Re: "Lytton Rancheria Homelands Act of 2015"

Dear Representative Huffman:

The Windsor Fire Protection District (District) has enjoyed a mutually-supportive relationship with the Lytton Rancheria (the Tribe) for several years. With the introduction of HR 2538, the "Lytton Rancheria Homelands Act of 2015," I would like to confirm that the Tribe has honored all aspects of the agreement between the two parties.

The District entered into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Tribe applicable to its proposed project to build housing for its members and for the development of governmental and community facilities, on land to be acquired in trust for the Tribe within the District's geographical boundaries. Under the MOA, the District will continue to provide service to the project. In return, the Tribe has agreed to make a capital contribution and other payments to the District to cover the District's expected impacts from the provision of such services. Further, the Tribe has agreed to other measures requested by the District, such as compliance with the California Fire Code and the local ordinance pertaining to Fire Safe Standards.

Again, the District has found the Tribe to be very attentive to the provisions of the MOA and looks forward to working together in the years to come.
